St. Joseph's Youth Camp - Dress Code Policy

St. Joseph's Youth Camp supports dress and grooming standards that encourage a culture of learning and well-being. Counselors and campers are expected to dress in a manner that is appropriate for a **rural camping environment**. Dress and grooming standards will be applied consistently and enforced. Use common sense and remember that your child will be in an outdoor camp setting that includes running, jumping, hiking, volleyball, horseback riding, and kayaking, etc.

General requirements

- Clothing must include a top and a bottom (shirts, sweatshirts, shorts, pants, leggings).
- Shorts must be at least mid-thigh (between the groin and the knee) but no more than 6-inches above the knee.
- Clothing should NOT contain insignia that may be offensive to other Campers, Counselors, or Staff. Political, social causes, bad language, anti-religious, sexual, or anything racial in nature will NOT be permitted. Symbols, crude designs (skull/crossbones), or anything that could be interpreted as offensive will not be permitted.
- Pants shall be kept at the hips with a belt if needed, no sagging.
- Clothing must have material that covers the entire front, back, and sides (no cleavage-baring or midriff-baring shirts).
- Clothing must cover all private body parts and undergarments and must not be see-through.
- Tops must be secured with material at the shoulders or neck (no tube-tops).
- Clothing may not cover a camper's face to the extent that the Camper is not identifiable (except clothing worn for health and safety, medical, or religious purposes).
- Closed-toed shoes shall be worn at all times, except for shower time routines.
- Headwear, including but not limited to hats, hoodies, and bandanas, is permitted.

CAMPERS DISMISSED FROM CAMP FOR DRESS CODE VIOLATIONS WILL NOT RECEIVE A REFUND OF ANY FEES PAID TO ATTEND CAMP.
