2020 Counselor Requirements and deadlines for Parents

Please send the following documents immediately:

1. A copy of the Candidates **HEALTH INSURANCE CARD both FRONT and BACK** (if... you do not have health insurance contact the Camp Secretary for possible resources.)
2. Signed (and initialed where designated) Waivers (permission slips) for **Horseback Riding, Kayaking and Flagstaff Extreme** to the Business office. Mail to:

other Required Documents: 3 REFERENCES

Attached is a **RECOMMENDATION FORM** Letter that you will need to give to your references. Instructions are on the form for completion and should be **mailed or emailed by the person completing the form.**

Be sure to print **your name and phone number on the form** before you give it to your Reference.

You must have **3 recommendations** and they **MUST be received** by the deadline, **April 30th, 2020.** Be sure to tell the person recommending you of the deadline.

All documents above MUST be received by: April 30th, 2020

Whether you are riding the bus to camp, being driven, or if you are driving yourself, these documents must be RECEIVED in the **Business Office by the APRIL 30th DEADLINE.** Documents cannot be accepted at check-in. If these documents are not received, you will not be able to participate in the activities or be eligible for assignments.

2020 Counselor Notes continued :

NOTE: If you are selected to return as a Camp Counselor During camp sessions, Location, Check-in and pick-up times are the same as on your Transportation sheet.

Counselors must be signed in and out by a parent, legal guardian or authorized person.

Counselors are not allowed to have a car at the campsite without express written permission.

If authorized, car insurance and registration is required and is at the owner's risk.

Please note: Counselors are not allowed to use a vehicle at the campsite once checked in.

Keys must be turned in to the Camp Director.

If you are eligible to earn Community Service hours, you must bring the form you need Completed to your Head Counselor at the beginning of the week you are assigned to help. It is the Head Counselor 's responsibility to complete this form.

Counselor Attire:

Counselors are given 5 SJYC t-shirts for the week.

Female Counselors are expected to dress conservatively with regard to shorts (shorts should not be worn if shorter than 4 fingers above the knee) if shorter...Black jumper pants (bicycle pants) **MUST** be worn under the short shorts.

Counselor t-shirts should NOT be cut or worn with sleeves rolled up.

Flip Flops are not appropriate footwear for Camp.

Inappropriate attire will be addressed by the Camp Director.

All Counselors are reminded to wear Counselor t-shirts at all times.

Please **do not pack** food/snacks or money in luggage.

Food is not allowed in cabins. Healthy snacks are provided and eaten in designated areas.

Clothes and Personal items must be stored in a duffle bag, laundry bag, or suitcase.

All luggage, duffle bags, back packs, etc. **MUST** have the **Counselors name** on it.

Items or Medicine **not picked up** at Bus Pick up or left at Camp will be donated or destroyed.

Remind your Counselor of how many carry bags they are taking and should bring home.

St. Joseph's Youth Camp is not responsible for items left or lost.

BRING ALL Prescription MEDICATION to Check-in.

RX's must be in the original medicine bottle, with the CAMPER name and dosage displayed.

All prescription medications will be given to the camp Nurse. No EXPIRED Medications accepted.

All Rx's must be written in English. All inhalers, Nebulizers or EPI pens MUST have a CURRENT RX.

The Camp Nurse has most over the counter medications / remedies. No need to send these.

CELL PHONES, or any other electronic devices are **NOT ALLOWED**.

Please ensure that **NO phones** are given to a Counselor to bring to camp **unless** prior management approval is obtained for **job assignment on the Bus**.

Toss away cameras are okay to bring. Phone cameras are not okay.

Do not send anything expensive or a family heirloom. Items can get lost or broken.

CAMP STORE MONEY will be collected at Check-in. Please put all money in an envelope with your counselor's name on it. Do not seal until turned in. Camp Store money is non-refundable.
